Love in Action Van – Outreach Ministry

Our Love in Action Vans are directly serving more than 100 homeless souls on the streets of Houston daily. If you would like to distribute snacks, water bottles, hygiene items, pray for and minister to those living in the streets, join our Outreach Ministry and make a difference in the lives of those who need it most.

Serve Meals - MDC/WFDC

We serve three meals a day, 365-days per year, at each Star of Hope campus. What an opportunity to encourage and uplift as you hand meal trays to our clients. Individual volunteers or small groups are scheduled on an on-going or one-time basis. Volunteers help set-up — which may include tasks such as prepping veggies, making sack lunches or organizing the pantry — serve and clean-up.

Adult Program Supply Kit - Off-site

During their stay at Star of Hope our residents attend programmatic classes daily and need supplies to be successful in accomplishing their educational and career goals. Gather friends and family and assemble program supply kits for our adult residents. You can collect the items by hosting a drive or purchasing them.

Host Snacks and Goodnight - Women and Family Development Center

Who does not love an evening snack? It can be a long time between dinner and breakfast when you cannot raid the fridge for a snack. Volunteers have a wonderful time visiting with clients as they provide and serve an evening snack. Volunteers arrive between 7:15 PM - 7:30 PM. Snack time is over at 8:15 PM. Volunteers help sweep-up and sign-out by 8:30 PM.

Hope Bags - Off-site

Prepare Hope Bags that meet immediate, daily needs of the men, women, and children of our city. You may assemble hygiene bags and /or snack bags.

Make Sack Lunches - MDC/WFDC/Off-site

Sack lunches are an everyday need for residents who are out job searching, at social service appointments or just arrived at our shelter. Sack lunches consist of a sandwich (condiments on the side) and a few sides such as chips, snack bars, fruit, and/or dessert. We also ask that you provide bottled water to be distributed with the lunch.

Housewarming Gift Baskets - Off-site

Moving into a new home is exciting and a dream come true for many of our residents. Many things are needed to make it feel like home, and that is where you come in. Gather friends and family to assemble housewarming baskets for our residents transitioning from Star of Hope into their new homes.

BAM - Bring a Meal - WFDC/MDC

Our guests love special meals themed for a holiday or just for fun! Put on a luau or Mexican fiesta, offer to host a good old-fashioned BBQ or bring in music and dessert. Your group can design the entire dining experience for our clients.
