Partnering with churches and community agencies, our team provides services and awareness in underserved areas. Serving the near-homeless, unsheltered homeless, and formerly homeless, the Outreach department identifies needs and works with resources and partner agencies to meet those needs.

The Outreach department hosts community events to spread the Gospel, provide services and referrals to those in Houston and surrounding areas, and create awareness of all the aspects of Star of Hope Mission.

STAR Outreach accepts calls, walk-ins, web inquiries, and other requests for assistance.

- From prayer to social services referrals, STAR Outreach assists in diverting or preventing families/individuals from becoming homeless when possible.
- STAR Outreach can also assist with furniture, household items, and other donations available to help with those establishing new residences.
- To qualify for services, families and individuals must meet the following criteria:
 - o Meet income guidelines
 - o Written statement of need
 - o Identification (TX DL or ID for adults; birth certificates for children)
 - o Income statement
 - o Verification of Housing
- Verification and qualification process is required for STAR Outreach services and is done on the phone and/or in person.
