WFDC Admissions Criteria

Must be homeless

Single female without children or single parent with children age 18 or older

U.S. citizen or legal resident

Willing and able to comply with facility and program rules and requirements

Able to physically care for self

Mentally and emotionally stable

Have not lived at Star of Hope in the past 12 months

Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Based on availability, first come, first served walk-in basis.



Star of Hope Women and Family Development Center (WFDC) is a Christ-centered residential facility serving homeless single women and single parent families. Our on-site programs are designed to help each person achieve greater self-determination and increase their potential for maintaining independent living. There are opportunities to remain in our program for up to 12 months. Our facility provides case management, meals, and other services for all residents in a structured, supportive environment.

New Pathways: 30-day Bible-based program

New Hope: 90-day substance abuse treatment. Must have at least

7 days of sobriety

New Journey: Independent living skills and spiritual enrichment

for ages 18 to 24

Personal Development: Spiritual enrichment and life skills

Biblical Counseling: Discover God's purpose for your life and incorporate it into everyday life

GED: Language arts, math, science, and social studies for non-high school graduates

Workforce Development: Improve job search skills and employability

Rise: Assists residents in maintaining employment

Restore: Accommodates the elderly and those who struggle with physical or mental illness

Pinky's Place: A state licensed program for children ages 6-weeks through 17-years old
